Chocolate and Sweets

Chocolate consists of two toxic chemical compounds - theobromine and caffeine. Many gums, mints, & baked goods contain the toxic compound xylitol.

Household Plants

Assume all can be hazardous and be cautious around pets. Be especially mindful when using bleach, vinegars, dishwashing detergent, toilet bowl cleaners, and lye.
